What type of homework will be set and how often will it be set?

English	Weekly	Students will be set self-marking quizzes on Google Classroom on information from their Knowledge Organiser. They will also be set some mindmap activities.
Maths	Weekly	Students will be set a self-marking task on MathsWatch based on their Knowledge Organiser and the work they will have been completing in lessons.
Science	Weekly	Students will be given a login for 'Boost' all home learning will be learning core Science questions based on the topics they will be studying. There will also be online quizzes set through Boost. Weekly tests on the core questions will be completed in class and scores put on Class Charts.
History	Fortnightly	Students will be set self marking quizzes on their google classroom. The questions will be linked to the History Knowledge Organisers which are relevant to the topic being studied at the time.
Geography	Fortnightly	Students will be set self marking quizzes via a link on their Google Classroom. The questions will be linked to the Geography Knowledge Organisers and work completed in lessons.
French	Fortnightly	Students will be asked to complete Blooket quizzes on a selection of words from their Knowledge Organiser via a link on their Google classroom. Then, they will be tested in class by doing a spelling test.
Art	Half-Termly	Students will be tested on the information in their knowledge organiser, including keywords, definitions and 'How To' guides related to Art.
Computing	Half-Termly	Students will be tested on information including key words and definitions. As well as practical activities to demonstrate their understanding of technological concepts and skills
Ethics & Philosophy	Half-Termly	Students will be tested on their knowledge of key words/definitions and key teachings from the unit using a short quiz. This will take place in class rather than online.
Music	Half-Termly	Students will be set tasks to demonstrate their knowledge of musical elements and keywords via the medium of quizzes and musical exercises. They will also be set rehearsal tasks.
PE	Half-Termly	Where possible, attend an after school sports club to learn new skills and have some fun!
