What type of homework will be set and how often will it be set?

English	Weekly	Students will complete a mixture of online quizzes using Google Forms and some analytical writing tasks, similar to what they do in lessons.
Maths	Weekly	Students will be set a self-marking task on MathsWatch based on their Knowledge Organiser and the work they will have been completing in lessons.
Science	Weekly	Students will be given a login for 'Boost' all home learning will be learning core Science questions based on the topics they will be studying. There will also be online quizzes set through Boost. Weekly tests on the core questions will be completed in class and scores put on Class Charts.
History	Weekly	Students will be set self marking quizzes on their Google Classroom. The questions will be linked to the History Knowledge Organisers which are relevant to the topic being studied at the time.
Geography	Weekly	Students will be set self marking quizzes via a link on their google classroom. The questions will be linked to the Geography knowledge organisers and work completed in lessons.
Spanish	Weekly	Students will be asked to complete Blooket quizzes on a selection of words from their Knowledge Organiser via a link on their Google classroom. Then, they will be tested in class by doing a spelling test.
Art and Design	Weekly	Students will be tested on the information in their Knowledge Organiser, including keywords, definitions and 'How To' guides related to Art. Students will also be expected to work on their portfolios at home or after school in open studio sessions, including weekly observational drawing tasks.
Business	Weekly	Students will be tested on the information on their Knowledge Organiser as well as a range of practical and problem solving tasks related to the topics being delivered.
Dance	Weekly	Students will be set a range of different tasks depending on genre of study. These will be a mix of practical and written. They will need to be able to confidently recall key ballet vocabulary, performance and technical skills and demonstrate knowledge of choreographers' works.
Drama	Weekly	Students will need to demonstrate their ability to recall key facts about practitioners, performance techniques and key drama terminology. This will be tested either by a

		multiple choice quiz or with questions that require students to practise extended writing.
Hair	Weekly	Students will be set research tasks which will relate to the upcoming lesson to help prepare them. This will include key words. They will also be set design tasks such as posters and information guides to show their understanding of certain aspects within a topic.
Media	Weekly	Students will be set a mix of self-marking quizzes on the google classroom and creative design tasks to demonstrate their knowledge of how different types of media are used.
Music	Weekly	Students will be set rehearsal, composition and musical theory tasks as well as quizzes and listening tasks.
Photography	Weekly	Students will be tested on the information in their Knowledge Organiser, including keywords, definitions and 'How To' guides related to Photography. Students will also be expected to work on their portfolios at home or after school in open studio sessions, including taking weekly photoshoots (min 30 images).
Psychology	Weekly	Students will need to demonstrate their ability to recall facts about key psychologists, experiments and theories in quizzes along with key words and their definitions. This will take place in a quiz in class rather than online.
Religious Studies	Weekly	Students will need to demonstrate their ability to recall facts, statistics and key words and definitions by taking part in quizzes in class rather than online.
Sport	Weekly	Quiz questions related to the Knowledge Organiser which is based on the topics being learnt in the lesson.
