What type of homework will be set and how often will it be set?

English	Weekly	Students will be set weekly Home Learning that consists of revision cards, revision posters, practice paragraphs, and quizzes.
Maths	Weekly	Students will be set a self-marking task on MathsWatch based on their CGP Knowledge Organiser and the work they will have been completing in lessons.
Science	Weekly	Students will be required to login to Pearson Revise online using their school gmail account. Home learning will be based on learning key information from the online revision guide and online quizzes. Weekly tests will take place based on the revision guide pages and scores will be added to class charts.
History	Weekly	Students will be set self marking quizzes or exam style practice questions on their Google Classroom. The questions will be linked to the History Knowledge Organisers which are relevant to the topic being studied at the time.
Geography	Weekly	Students will be set self marking quizzes via a link on their google classroom. The questions will be linked to the Geography Knowledge Organisers and work completed in lessons.
Spanish	Weekly	<p>Students will be asked to complete Blooket quizzes on a selection of words from their revision guides via a link on their Google Classroom. Then, they will be tested in class by doing a spelling test.</p> <p>Additionally, they will have practise exam style questions from the four key skills to prepare them for their GCSE exams. This will include tasks from the activeteach online books.</p>
Art and Design	Weekly	Students will be tested on the information in their Knowledge Organiser, including keywords, definitions and 'How To' guides related to Art. Students will also be expected to work on their portfolios at home or after school in open studio sessions, including weekly observational drawing tasks.
Business	Weekly	Students will be tested on the information from their Knowledge Organiser as well as a series of multiple choice and short answer questions related to each topic delivered.

Computer Science	Weekly	Students will be tested on their knowledge and understanding of key technological concepts. This will include practical activities and short answer or multiple choice questions
Dance	Weekly	Students will be set choreographic rehearsal tasks that relate to their recent and prior learning. They will also be expected to complete questions from section A and B of the GCSE Dance exam paper, as well as watching and making notes on the set GCSE anthology works.
Drama	Weekly	Students will be set practice questions from the GCSE Drama exam paper. There will either be multiple choice drama knowledge questions, or they will be required to write an extended answer for the drama tech question at the beginning of the paper.
Hair	Weekly	Students will be set research tasks which will relate to the upcoming lesson to help prepare them. This will include key words. They will also be set design tasks such as posters and information guides to show their understanding of certain aspects within a topic.
Media	Weekly	Students will be set quizzes, posters, and practice paragraphs based on information on their Knowledge Organiser as well as knowledge they have learnt in the classroom.
Music	Weekly	Students will be set composition, rehearsal and listening tasks as well as quizzes and revision exercises.
Photography	Weekly	Students will be tested on the information in their Knowledge Organiser, including keywords, definitions and 'How To' guides related to Photography. Students will also be expected to work on their portfolios at home or after school in open studio sessions, including taking weekly photoshoots (min 30 images).
Psychology	Weekly	Students will need to demonstrate their ability to recall facts about key psychologists, experiments and theories in quizzes along with key words and their definitions. This will be in the form of class quizzes.
Religious Studies	Weekly	Students will need to demonstrate their ability to recall facts, teachings and key words and definitions by taking part in quizzes in class rather than online.
Sport	Weekly	Google form quizzes/practice questions set on topics that have been covered in lessons relating to the Knowledge Organisers.
